JANUARY 19 - JANUARY 27, 2021

THE KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS COUNCIL 10208 ARE SPONSORING A 9 DAY NOVENA FOR LIFE AT SACRED HEART CATHOLIC CHURCH AND INVITE ALL PARISHIONERS TO PARTICIPATE

- JANUARY 19 Begins with 9:00 AM Mass and recitation of the “Gospel of Life Prayer”
Individuals say an Our Father, 3 Hail Mary’s, and reflect on “every life is worth living”
- JANUARY 20 Attend Mass at 9:00 AM and recite the “Gospel of Life Prayer”
Individuals say an Our Father, 3 Hail Mary’s, and fast from one meal today
- JANUARY 21 Attend Mass at 9:00 AM and recite the “Gospel of Life Prayer”
Individuals say an Our Father, 3 Hail Mary’s, and abstain from snacking today
- JANUARY 22 Attend mass at 9:00 AM and recite of the “Gospel of Life Prayer”
Individuals make a sacrifice or prayer for intercession that “expectant fathers lovingly support the mothers of their children in welcoming new life”
- JANUARY 23 Attend outdoor mass or 4:00 PM mass and recite the Gospel of Life Prayer”
Individuals say the Chaplet of Divine Mercy sometime during the day
- JANUARY 24 Attend one of the Sunday masses at church and recite the “Gospel of Life Prayer”
Offer a sacrifice or say prayers that expectant mothers choosing adoption receive grace and support in embracing this loving option
- JANUARY 25 Attend mass, if offered and recite the “Gospel of Life Prayer”
Individuals say an Our Father, 3 Hail Mary’s praying that all who support or participate in abortion will experience a conversion of heart to seek and receive the Lord’s boundless mercy
- JANUARY 26 Attend 9:00 AM mass at church and recite the “Gospel of Life Prayer”
Individuals say an Our Father, 3 Hail Mary’s praying that civic leaders will work for the protection of all human life in every stage and circumstance
- JANUARY 27 Attend 9:00 AM mass at church and recite the “Gospel of Life Prayer”
Individuals say an Our Father, 3 Hail Mary’s, and reflect on how God may be asking you to help build a culture of life in your home, Church, or community

Note: Participation in the Novena does not require that you complete every listed item. That is, if you cannot attend mass, you can still say some of the prayers and/or reflect on listed statements.
