She has regularly helped as an "ice cream scooper" as this guild has a fundraiser(s) at Men's Club dinners to raise money to support our youth in special dinners, beginning and end of the school year parties and receptions and gifts for those youth who are receiving sacraments at our parish. She has delivered food through Meals on Wheels, served and provided food for funeral receptions and contributed time and goodies for LOSH bake goods sales and food baskets.
