

SACRED HEART MEN'S RETREAT 2025



When it comes to people who get involved in ministries and activities in this wonderful parish, some are "first timers" and some have been active in previous parishes long before coming to Sacred Heart of Jesus Church.

A person who fits in the latter category is our "Very Important Person" for the month of January, Debbie Doughty. While living in Wisconsin she was a lector, E.M. (Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion), and served on the pastoral council of her local church. The 50/50 will work like your typical super bowl squares. The per square donation is \$20 and payout is as follows:


1st quarter: \$200, 2nd quarter: \$250 3rd quarter: \$200 and final score: \$350


